#### **Pastor's Corner**

Celebrating the Season of Lent
Wednesday, February 14th is Ash Wednesday and
marks the beginning of the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday, a day of fasting, occurs 46 days before Easter – 40
days of fasting, minus the six Sundays, which are not
days of fasting.

As we know from the stories in Matthew, Mark and Luke, Jesus spent 40 days fasting in the desert, where he endured temptation by Satan. Lent began as a mirroring of this, fasting 40 days as preparation for Easter. Every Sunday is to be seen as a commemoration of the Sunday that Christ rose from the dead, therefore fasting is not necessary as each Sunday is a "feast day."

At First Covenant Church, we use ashes made from the palm branches that are used to celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. Each of us, as a way of remembering the sacrifice of Christ on our behalf, are invited to receive the ashes hearing the words, "remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

But Ash Wednesday is more than just a ritual, and Lent is more than just giving up something we like. We celebrate Ash Wednesday, and fast during Lent as a way of remembering Jesus, his death on the cross, and the gift offered to us of living forever with him. We celebrate the birth of Jesus at Christmas and we celebrate his victory over death on Easter Sunday, but in between, we also need to remember his sacrifice and the depth of his love for all of humanity that led him to the cross.

"You are invited, therefore, in the name of the Church, to the observance of a holy Lent, by self-examination and repentance; by holy prayer, fasting, and self-denial; and by reading and meditating on God's holy world."

course of 18 days. An estimated 234 athletes will wear the Stars and Stripes.








